#### APPLYING YOUR CRITTER ON THE MOVE DECAL

1. Make sure your new Critter will fit on your vehicle's window where you plan to place him.
2. Decal is to be placed on outside of the vehicle window. Clean window thoroughly.
3. Using window cleaner or a soapy water solution (about 50/50) spray the window until it is lightly wet.
4. Remove your critter from the backing paper and place on the window. The sticker should slide freely if the window is wet enough. If not, pull the sticker off and apply more liquid to the area.
5. Slide the critter into position on the vehicle window. Align the bottom of the decal with the bottom of the window. Starting at center of the decal, using a squeegee or an old credit card, carefully squeegee out to the edges of the decal. Continue until all liquid has been forced out from under the decal. Be sure all of the excess liquid has been removed & the decal is properly squeegeed at the at the bottom of the decal at the rubber seal to prevent damage to the decal when the window is lowered. Do not lower the window for 24 hours. Helpful Hint: If the rubber seal at the base of your vehicles window is flexible and moveable, you may want to carefully slide the decal down approximately 1/8" below where he rubber seal makes contact with the decal. Check for air pockets. If any pockets are detected, simply squeegee the air to the edge.
6. Using a paper towel, carefully blot all the excess liquid from around the decal. Let dry for 24 hours.
